- Seeking an entry-level operator's license; or a licensed entry-level or above operator seeking professional development.

Application

The application will be reviewed based on the answer to the following questions and employer recommendation letter.

- 1. Name
- 2. Email
- 3. WEF Membership Number
- 4. Current employer
- 5. Island of residence
- A short introduction / biography of yourself so we can get to know you. [consider including information related to your education, career path, current place of employment, job function(s), extracurricular activities, and/or hobbies]. (100 Word Limit)
- 7. Describe why you would like to attend **WEFTEC 2022** and what you most hope to gain through participation. (100-Word Limit)
- 8. Essay on one of the following questions. (200-Word limit)
 - a. Why did you select this career?
 - b. How do you want to contribute to the field/industry?
 - c. What are your career goals?



HWEA will provide up to \$3000 to cover travel expenses (airfare, 4 nights hotel, registration, and ground transportation) to **WEFTEC 2022 October 10-12 in New Orleans**. To assist the Selection Committee, please provide a 1-page letter from your employer, which includes approval to attend and at least two reasons why you should attend **WEFTEC 2022**.

Selection

The Selection Committee will review applications for completeness, professionalism, and responses to questions. Incomplete applications will not be eligible for award. Up to four operators will be selected.

Responsibility of Awardees

- Before conference:
 - Self-register before July 29 for Full Conference & Expo as a Professional Operator Member
 - Self-arrange travel accommodations
 - Submit budgetary expenses to HWEA for review
- During conference
 - Attend Operations Challenge with PWO Representative
 - Achieve a minimum of 6 contact hours per day to apply for continuing education credits by attending technical sessions and the exhibition hall. WEFTEC participation is tracked using badges provided during registration or onsite pickup. Be sure to scan your badge for credits when entering and exiting each session. For exhibition related credits, attendees will be required to scan badges at the CE Kiosks located near hall entrances.
 - o Attend the HWEA's WEFTEC social event
- After attending the conference
 - Provide a photo and paragraph write up of your experience for publication in HWEA's newsletter, Lua Line
 - Complete a video interview about your experience
 - Submit expense report to HWEA for reimbursement (airfare, 4 nights hotel, registration, and ground transportation)
 - Submit your documentation of attendance to the Hawaii Board of Certification for CEU credit
 - Complete any employer and tax required paperwork
